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AYURVEDIC MANAGEMENT OF VICHARCHIKA W.S.R. TO ECZEMA- A CASE STUDY

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ABSTRACT

All Kushthas are having Tridoshaja origin; hence Vicharchika can be explained in similar manner. Vicharchika (Eczema) is a type of Kshudrakustha often encountered by Ayurvedic Dermatologists characterized with symptoms, namely, Kandu (itching), Srava (discharge), Pidaka (vesicles), and Shyava Varna (discoloration). It is one of the non contagious inflammation of the skin. Vicharchika to a greater extent resembles eczema/dermatitis of modern science. The involvement of Vata results in dry, blackish lesion of eczema, itching in the affected areas is due to Kapha where as Pitta is responsible for Srava. Though, the disease Vicharchika is not life threatening, it makes the patient worried due to its appearance, severe itching, disturbing routine. Its nature is susceptible to be chronic. In classical texts of Ayurveda, Acharyas emphasizes Shodhana and Shamana therapy as the line of treatment at various places in the management of Kushtha. Among the Shodhana Karmas, Virechana is chiefly advocated, purificatory measures in Vicharchika. Virechana is not only a mere bowel cleaning procedure but also has systemic effects. Acharya Charaka has advocated Virechana for the Pitta Dosha and Rakta Dushti (Ch.Chi.7/39). A case of 30 year old female patient, presented with Kandu, Daha, Rukshata, Srava, Vedana, Vaivarnya, Raji etc lakshanas of Vicharchika on her Pristh Pradesh (Back region), Ubhay Pad Pradesh (Lower Limb), Ubhaya Hasta Pradesh (Upper Limb) since last 4 yrs. She was taking oral Antifungal, analgesic drugs daily since 4yrs. As the patient was tired of the medicines and recurrence of the disease, visited to Parul Institute of Ayurveda Vadodara for further treatment. Purpose of study was aimed to evaluate efficacy of Trivritta Choorna for Virechana Karma and Shamanaushdhi on Vicharchika and thus forming key of successful remedy in Vicharchika for focusing its trial on large populations. She was administered with Samyaka procedure of Virechan Karma For 2 times. After Shodhan, Shaman Aushadhi was administered for 15 days. The above clinical features of patient were significantly improved by 51days. Routine Laboratory findings were within normal limit. Virechana as a Samshodhana therapy, and Shaman Aushadhi both in combinations when followed systematically, give relief from symptoms in patients of Vicharchika.it not only stopped her contempary medicines but recurrence was controlled.

INTRODUCTION

Skin is the largest organ of body, near about 20 square feet in surface area. It is one of the five special sense organs¹. It protects the internal organs, muscles, bones from deleterious environmental influences like temperature, infectious organisms, chemicals and mechanical injuries etc. Majority of the skin disease are not fatal, but create comparatively greater stress and strain to the patient. Another reason for the skin diseases being more painful and irritant and some of them are contagious. In current era, modern medical science, have

lots of facilities and upgraded technologies for treatment portion of patient, even though many diseases may still in progressive phase in the society. *Vicharchika* is one such kind of disorders.

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Means the skin disease where eruptions over the skin appear with dark pigmentation, itching with profuse discharge from the lesion.

Vicharchika is type of Kshudra Kushtha (Chronic Skin disease). Included under Rakta Pradoshaja Vikaras.

Eczema occurs after coming in contact with irritant or allergen. Its pathway involves inflammatory mediators, for example, prostaglandins, Helper T cells. Its clinical features are redness, swelling, scaling, weeping, and crusting, and itching. All severe forms of eczema have a huge effect on life quality. Effective therapeutic agents in contemporary medicine are limited in number and may have long-term toxic side effects. ^[2] The prevelance of eczema is rising and has increased between twofold and fivefold over the last 30 years. It now affects 1 in 10 schoolchildren. Recent evidence suggests that expouser to probiotics in late pregnancy and early infancy reduces the incidence of eczema. ^[3]

The main stay of treatment in *Ayurveda* for *Vicharchika* is *Shodhan* Which eliminate the Vitiataed *doshas*, Parallel to *Shodhan Shaman Oushadhis* help to correct the *Dhatus* and bring them to normalcy.

Virechana is the prime procedure for Pitta Dosha⁴. Virechana drug after entering Amashaya dislodges the vitiated Pitta Dosha and henceforth pacifies all Pitta Vikara of the body, just like a house which consists of fire will not only become hot when fire is made hot by adding suitable fuel and cooled when it is cooled.^[5]

CASE SUMMARY

A case of 30 year old female patient, presented with Teevra Kandu, Teevra Daha, Rukshata, Srava (lasikavat), Teevra Vedana, Vaivarnya, Raji on her Prustha Pradesh (Back region), Ubhay Pad Pradesh (Lower Limb), Ubhaya Hasta Pradesh (Upper Limb) since last 4 yrs.

METHODOLOGY

Selection of Patient

As the patient was having severe *Kandu, Daha*, occasionally *Srava* or *Rukshata, Pidika, Vaivarnya, Raji* and *Vedana* etc. from last 4 yrs. She was registered for present study in OPD of Parul institute of Ayurveda Hospital, Limda ,Vadodara on 28/05/2018. Depending upon signs and symptoms the patient was diagnosed as *Vicharchika* (Eczema). Patient was administered with *Virechana Karma* For 2 times followed by *Shamanousdhis* for 15Days.

Treatment Protocol

The patient was first explained the need of *Shodhan* therapy i.e. *Virechana*. *Virechana* is most important appraise for *Kushtha*. It is a specific modality for the elimination of *Pitta Dosha* but it is also effective upon *Vata, Kapha Dosha* as well as *Rakta*. ^[6]

Patient was strictly instructed for *Pathyapathya* at the time of *Snehapana* that use of warm Water, Abstinence from Sexual activity, only night sleep, and not suppress the natural urges etc. [7]

Also instructed about ashta *Pariharya Vishaya* that is loud speech, travelling in chariot, excessive walking, sedentary habbit, intake food during digestion, falty intake of food, day sleep, coitus etc. [8]

The details of Treatment protocol are as follows,

During *Snehapana* daily *Jiryaman* and *Jirna lakshanas* were observed. When all *Samyaka lakshanas* were produced i.e. on 7th day with 230ml of *Panchtikta-ghrita*, *Snehapana* was stopped. In *Virechana karma* 21 vegas were observed.

After the completion of *Sanasarjan Karma*, after expelling a large quantity of *Pittadi doshas* still patient was having *Pitta Utkleshit Avastha*. Patient advised for the rest for 1 day and once again *Samsodhan* therepy i.e. *Virechana Karma* was planned. In Table no. 2 details are as follows.

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DISCUSSION

Virechana Karma expels out the Doshas dragging them towards the Adhobhaga through the Guda. Amashaya is the specific seat of Pitta and Kapha. Though Virechana is a specific therapy for Pitta Dosha, it also acts on Kapha Dosha. Virechana drugs with the Ushna, Tikshna, Sukshma, Vyavayi and Vikasi properties reaches the Hridaya by virtue of its Virya then following the Dhamani it spreads the whole body through large and small Srotasa. Virechaka drugs by their properties bring the morbid humour from the Shakha to Kshotha. Dominant Pruthvi and Jala mahabhoota take these Doshas towrds. Prabhav of the medicine is responsible for expulsion of these Doshas out of the body by rectal root. 10 With criteria of Samyaka Virechana, Vaigiki and Maniki are considered mainly for deciding the Samsarjana Krama. Ayoga and Atiyoga Lakshanas were

checked during the procedure to avoid complication and for its early management.

In the present study, *Trivritta Choorn* was selected for *Virechana Karma Trvritta Churn* has property for *Sukha Virechak*. [11] Trivrutta Choorna has Madhura Kashaya, Tikta Rasa, Katu Vipaka and Ushna Veerya [12] With Madhura , Kashaya, Tikta Rasa, Trivrutta helps to pacify or expelled out *Pitta Dhosha*. Trvritta was having Kushthaghna, Krimighna, Rakta Shodhana and also Tridoshaghna properties [13]. So effect of drug itself was found to be helpful in the reduction of the disease.

1. Aarogyavardhini Rasa

Aarogyavardhini Rasa is herbomineral formulation.It is having ingridents like Shuddha Parada, Shuddha Gandhak, Lauha Bahsma ,Tamra Bhasma , Triphla churna, Shuddha Shilajita , Kutaki,Cchitrak Mool. With Bhavana of Nimba Patra Swarasa etc it is explained in

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Kustharogadhikar. Primarily advised in Kushtha Vikara i.e. all type of skin diseases. most of the Dravyas having Tikta Rasa. [14] Its primary site of action is Grahani and Pakwashaya. It is very potent drug to increase Agni which is a very important ingredient to correct the multiple dushya levels in Kushtha. Not only it helps in all types of Dosha predominant conditions, it also helps in their elimination from the body by its Bhedan and Malashuddhi kar activity. [15]

2. Panchtikta Ghritta guggulu

This is a very potent drug of choice in *Kushtha Adhikar*. It is indicated in *Visham* and *Atiprabala Vata*. *Nimba*, *Guduchi*, *Patola*, *Kantakari*, *Vasa* are the contents of *Panch tikta*. ¹⁶ *Guggulu* is *yogavahi dravya*. It is having many medicinal properties. like improve digestion, Purify the blood, It is also beneficial in skin disorders of *Vata* and *Kapha* pridominency. Probable mode of action of *Panchtikta ghritta guggulu* can be consider as, All properties of this drug acts on cellular level of skin decreasing keratinization of skin layer thus improving cell cycle as a result of these symptoms like itching, extensive patches, unctuous, and raised blckish colour of patches were reduced. ^[17]

3. Gandhak Rasayan

It is a Herbomineral formulation. It is having ingridents like – Shudh Gandhka ,with Bhavana of Different *Kwath*, *Swaras* etc.Example – *Guduchi Swaras*, *Godugadh*, *Aadraka Swaras* etc. it is indicated in Kustha *Vyadhi*. It is having Anti fungal Activity, [19] It is used in the treatment of Skin Diseases Itching on the lesion. It is also useful in bleeding disorder It Effects on *Tridosh* i.e. *Vata Pitta and Kapha*. It act as anti bacterial anti Viral, anti pruritic and anti inflammatory agent. it is a very good blood purifier.

4. Combinataion of Avipattikar choorn + Jatamanshi choorn+ Katuki Choorn - (For Nitya Virechana karma)

- In This Avipattikar Choorn is an ayurvedic herbal mix Powder .It is composed of 14 ingredients. Avipattikar choorn exhibit antiulcer property, it is also having mild laxative property .Contents of Avipattikar choorn such as Lavang, Vidang, Trikatu, and Nagarmotha have Deepan and Pachan property where as Nishoth and Triphla are Laxative in Nature. All have Pitta and Kaphashamak property Mishri is Vata-Pittashamak due to Madhura rasa. [20]
- Jatamanshi Choorn has laghu, Snigdh guna Tikata, Kashaya, Madhur Rasa, Katu Vipak and Sheet Virya and Manas doshara property. It Balances all the three Doshas, But has special effect on Pitta and Kapha Dosha. It is also having Antioxident property. It has anti Fungal activity. [21]
- Katuki Choorn is a Ayurvedic hurb It is having Ruksha Laghu, Guna Tikta Rasa katu Vipak and Sheet virya It balances Kapha and Pitta Dosha In condition of Pitta inflicting the Rasa and Rakta Dhatu –Katuki by the is virtue of its Tikta Rasa and

Sheet virya it pacifies Pitta, it does Prasadan of those Dhatu too. A very lower dosage of Katuki Choorn augments the digestive fire (Jatharagni), Cleaness the blocked Srotases. It is also having AntiBacterial property. [22]

CONCLUSION

Virechana as Shodhana Chikitsa and Shamana Therapy, both in combinations when followed systematically, given relief from symptoms in patients of Vicharchika.

Disease *Vicharchika* can be managed successfully with *Ayurveda* and need to be studied in more number of patients.

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
