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ROLE OF CHITRAKADI GUTIKA IN GASTROINTESTINAL DISORDERS- A REVIEW

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ABSTRACT

ChitrakadiGutika explained in Charakasamhita Grahani Dosh Chikitsa Adhyaay also in yogaratnakar. In Grahani, Agni dushti takes place which generates Ama, hence foremost step to treat Grahani is Amapachana. Chitrakadi Gutika is a combination of all Amapachana and Agnideepanadravyas. It has a vast utilisation in Gastrointestinal diseases like Arsha sspecially sushkaarsha. This aushadhiyoga has laghu, rukshaguna, katurasa, katuvipaka, ushnaveerya, acts on VataKaphadosha and in Pittaja avastha of above diseases with use of different anupan like Nimbuswarasa, Annarrasa and Koshna jala. Following article aims to understand the Chitrakadi Gutika and its role in Grahani and other GI disorders.

INTRODUCTION

Grahani is an Ayurveda terms related to the seat of Agni (digestive fire), which help in the metabolism and digestion of food. The ancient text of Ayurveda described that ingestion, digestion, absorption and assimilation of Aahaar is regulated by Grahani. In modern Grahani is correlated with Gastrointestinal tract which is hollow organ, Twisting tube from mouth to the anus. When this Agni becomes; mandagni then improper digestion of ingested food leads pathological condition termed as Grahani Roga. Grahani is also called as Pittadhara Kala.^[1]Chitrakadi Vati is commonly used in gastrointestinal disorders mainly arises from Mandagni. Grahani Roga is one of the disorders which occur due to Mandagni which leads to Ama (Undigested Food Residue) formation in the body.^[2] Drugs present in the Chitrakadi Vati mainly of Katu Rasa, Laghu, Tikshana Guna, Usna Virya, Katu Vipaka, Deepana- Pachana-Anulomana- Rochana properties and have Kapha-Vata shamak action, which improves the Jatharagni by

relieving Ama.^[3] So Chitrakadi Vati shows Amahara action which can cure Grahani. Considering the anatomy and physiology of GI tract it can be correlated with Annavaha and Purishavaha Srotasa according to Ayurvedic parameters.

Considering the above causes and symptoms, *Ama Pachana* becomes a major step while treating pathologies of above two *strotasas*. Also, *Acharyas* has given treatment of *Annavahastrotasa* as treatment of *AmapradoshajVikara* and that of *PureeshvahaStrotasa* as treatment of *Atisara*, which includes *Amapachana*.

Chitrakadi Gutika

Chitrakadi Gutika is a well known combination used in *Grahani Vyadhi*. It is explained in *Charaka Chikitsa* 15,^[7] *Yogaratnakar*^[3] in *Grahanichikitsa* and also by *bhaishaya Ratnakar*^[8] take a same reference from *Charaka Samhita* regarding *Chitrakadi Gutika*. *Grahani* is a disease in which *Agni* derangement is the main event in *Samprapti*. *Chitrakadi Gutika* contains drugs which

have Deepana, Pachana, Rochana, Vata-anulomana, Shoolahara, properties which are Ushna virya, Katu, Lavana, Tikta, Madhura, Amla rasa, laghu tikshna, snigdha grahi guna prominent with katu vipaka and kaphavatahara action which improves the jatharagni by relieving Ama. Due to Madhura rasa and snigdha guna, it balances the pitta. Tikta and Katu rasa improves the digestion and made the first Dhatu in proper form, so the combination will act on the Rasa Dhatu. Deepan, Pachana and Grahi properties decrease Strotogata Ama and relieves Atipravritti. Drugs like Marich, Shunthi, Chitraka etc. are proved as a best Ama pachaka. So Chitrakadi Gutika shows Amahara action which can cure Grahani Dosha.^[7]

Chitrakadi Gutika is a potent digestive stimulant. It is a traditional remedy for treating indigestion, constipation, flatulence and stomach pain. The active ingredient Chitraka prevents mandagni. The carminative nature of the Gutika helps in breaking down of food particles in the stomach and intestine, enhances the secretion of the digestive juices and thereby increases the absorption of essential nutrients through the intestines. It helps to eliminate abdominal gas and in turn reduces abdominal distension, bloating and gaseous cramps. It holds high significance in treating a wide range of gastrointestinal disorders like esophagitis, heartburn, diarrhoea, flatulence, peptic ulcer and gastroesophageal reflux disease.

Dose^[12]

The optimum therapeutic dosage may vary from person to person depending upon the age, severity, and condition of the patient. The maximum dosage of this formulation should not exceed 2000 mg in a day and should depend on a person's weight and health condition 4 Rati = 500mg (1Rati = 125mg)

Adverse Effects Of Chitrakadi Vati^[11]

Chitrakad Gutikai doesn't characterize any side effects when used to treat an individual having *Kapha* disorders. In case, the person has *Pitta* disorders, the formulation may cause hyperacidity, heartburn, burning sensation in the abdomen and a burning feeling during bowel movements.

It is strictly forbidden from being used during pregnancy or breast-feeding as it can cause abnormalities or birth defects in the growing foetus or the medicine can get passed through breast milk to the new born and cause severe health problems.

Since *Chitrakadi Gutika* has four different types of salt, so in case of overdosage, the higher salt content in it may lead to high blood pressure, diabetes insipidus, gastritis, and hypernatremia.

Dignosis of Annavaha Srotasa^[13]

- In Liver function tests elevation in Serum creatinine (SCr) and BUN may be indicative of bleeding from the GI tract.
- Serum measurements of sodium chloride, and potassium are useful to determine electrolyte abnormalities associated with diarrheal illnesses.
- In imaging techniques, Plain and Contrast Radiography used for primary diagnostic technique helpful to evaluate Abdominal Pain. Quick assessment of abdominal masses, esophageal strictures, stones, etc.
- Ultrasonography (USG) and Computed Tomography (CT) is very useful to examine deeper abdominal organs also Magnetic Resonance Imaging is more sensitive than USG and CT to malignancies.
- Endoscopy is Useful for diagnostic evaluation in upper GI bleeding, obstructions, upper abdominal pain, persistent vomiting, and radiographic abnormalities.
- Examination of Stool like color, Ph, consistency ,pus cell, crystals etc. are helpful to evaluate any abnormality in GIT and alimentary canal.

CONCLUSION

Gastrointestinal disorder or *Vyadhis* of *Annadvaha* and *Purishvaha strotasa* as explained by *Ayurveda* can be correlated with *Agni*. Chitrakadi Gutika is powerful remedy used for treating a host of ailment like indigestion, loss of appetite, constipation, anorexia, diarrhoea, abdominal heaviness and distension. If take in the proper dosage, one can clearly avoid side effects and enjoy the countless health benefits.

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
